Frequently Asked Questions

When can I register?

The centre has continuous intake, allowing you to register and start throughout the school year.

How much will it cost?

There is a \$35.00 annual registration fee. You can complete more than one course at no extra cost.

How do I get help or instructions?

Tests or exams can be written online or at the centre.
